- Squareup A invoicing and accounting software for your business.
- HelloSign A legally binding electronic contract-signing software.
- Google Docs An easy-to-use method of file sharing and creation software.
- Canva A simplified design tool to create your marketing materials.
- Planoly An app used to plan and schedule Instagram posts.
- Paypal An alternative method for invoicing or paying subcontractors.
- DocHub A software that can be used to create floor plans.

The BEST part about all of the above, is that each is FREE to use. Meredith Events started with ZERO capital and thus had to find ways to stay organized and professional on no budget out of necessity. Since then, the systems have worked so well...they stuck!

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A wedding day timeline is the most essential part of wedding day organization. The Meredith Events timeline has been curated over several years and contains every detail of coordinating a wedding effectively.

What is in a timeline? THE ENTIRE KITCHEN SINK!

The first couple of years I started my wedding planning business, I was charging so very little that I asked my clients to create their own wedding day timeline. After a while, this wasn't working for me anymore. There were really pertinent things I needed to know that often couples left off when creating their own.

My first template was pretty basic. I put together a hodge podge of templates I found online mixed with good ideas from previous clients' timelines. Finally, I added my own details one by one.

For example, I would come home from a wedding and maybe the couple forgot to buy the pretty cake cutting utensils used for cake cutting photos. This would be added to my timeline the next day. This went on for years and the more I added, the longer and more complex the timeline became.

Eventually, the timeline became so long and complex that vendors were calling me after I emailed it out saying, "Well, I was going to refer to your timeline about this question, but I saw it was fifteen pages long so I thought I would call instead."

I knew something had to change. My latest version has been color-coded, simplified and cleaned up. The result is outstanding and I get a lot of compliments on my timeline! As my mentee, you will have access to learning more about this important document that took years to curate. Cool, huh?!

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS: today is your day!


